


The Voice of the Sexually Exploited

Sex buying is an abuse of power; it exists on a continuum of sexual violence









SUMMARY

The post self-assessment data suggest the SSE class has positive effects on attitudes and beliefs that effectively meets the goals of programming for sex buyers regarding:

- Personal decisions to NOT buy sex again;
- of gender-based violence;
- Changing beliefs and attitudes regarding the cultural prostitution; and
- Encouraging healthy masculinities.
